Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves a contract between the Metropolitan Board of Health and STARS Nashville.

Under the terms of the contract, STARS commits to leading the Nashville Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success e-cigarette and substance misuse capacity building, prevention, and messaging campaign. Metro commits to providing a full-time epidemiologist with expertise in substance abuse, research, and evaluation. Further, Metro will be responsible for all data collection and reporting for this project, provide education to 500 students annually, and serve on the Inter-agency Advisory Board.

The estimated annual value of this contract is \$72,098, not to exceed \$379,071 over the duration of the contract. The term of the contract would begin upon approval by all parties and filing in the Metro Clerk's Office and would end August 30, 2025.
