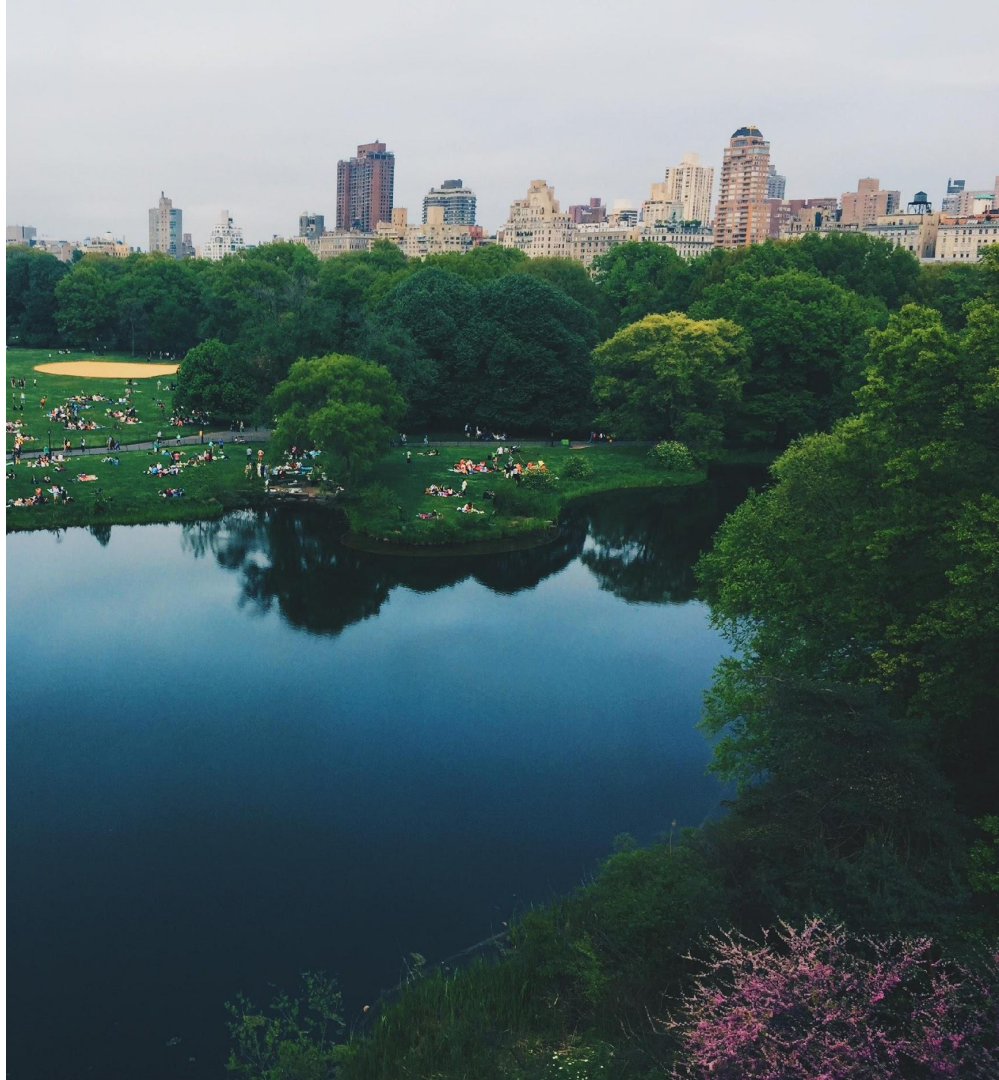

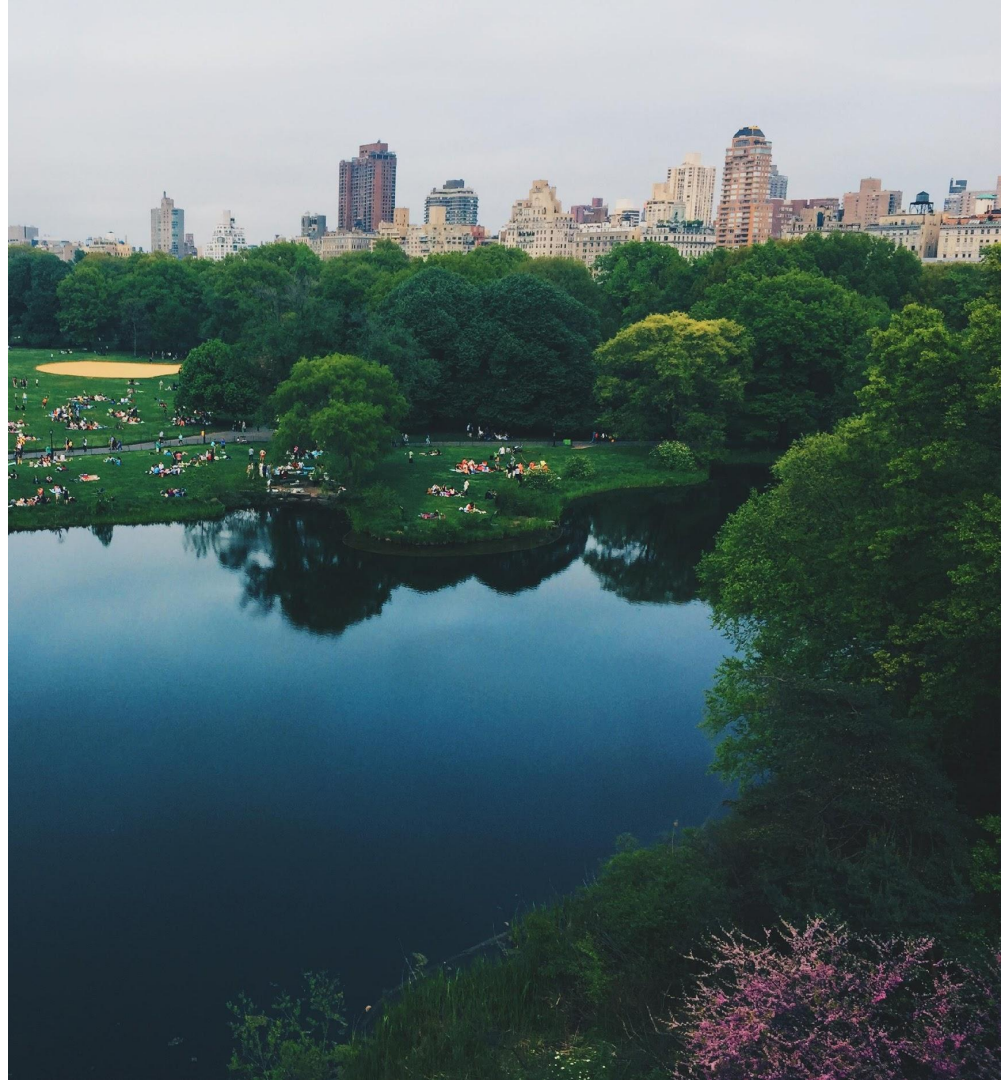
Bang the Table at-a-glance

- EngagementHQ software platform purpose-built for local government
- Founded in 2007
- Currently supports ~800 clients



What we heard

- Tennessee Open Meetings Act allows councilmembers to communicate with each other in an online forum, provided the public has ample access and notice
- Looking for an online forum solution for Councilmembers to discuss topics unrelated to official decision-making
- Requires functionality such that only Councilmembers can engage, but the public can view
