


On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 173 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer mains (VCP) and two sanitary sewer manholes and the acceptance of approximately 2,030 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer mains (PVC), approximately 651 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer mains (DIP), approximately 78 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer mains (PVC), approximately 95 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer mains (DIP), 21 sanitary sewer manholes, and any associated easements to serve the 253 Nesbitt Lane development.

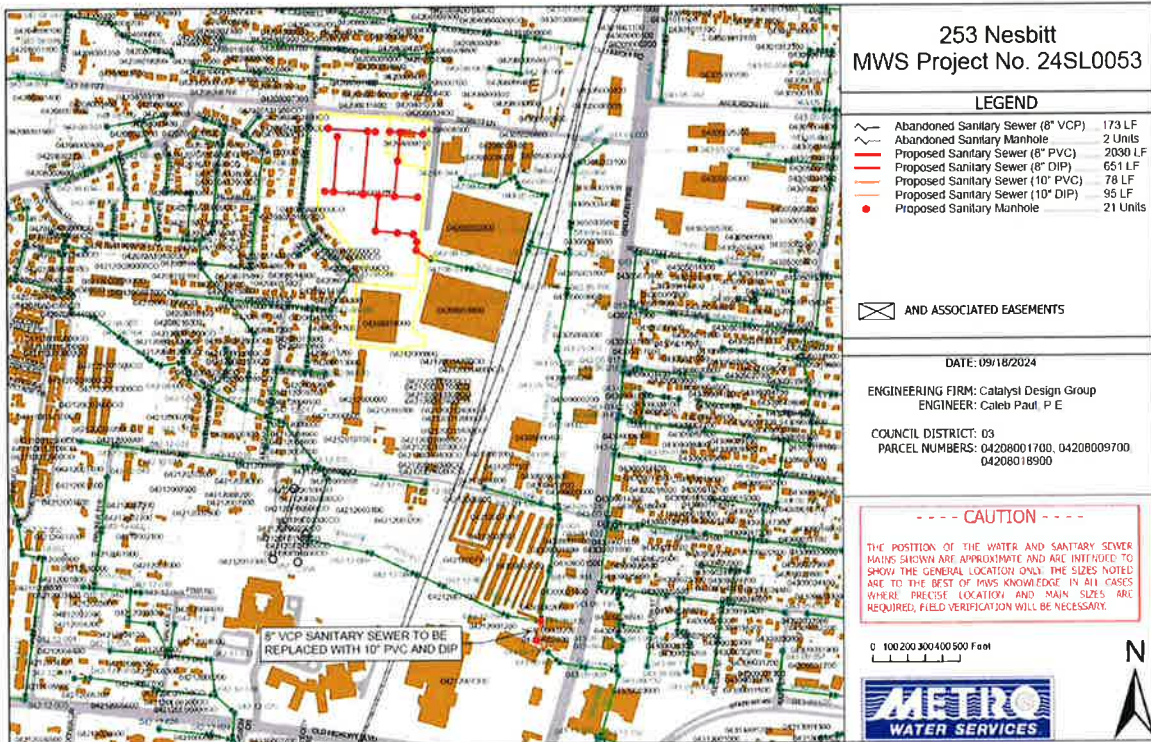
