On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for a Preliminary Engineering Agreement between RJ Corman Railroad Company and Metro acting through the Department of Water and Sewerage Services for property at 1201 Freightliner Drive. The project is in the design phase only and there is no digging planned at this time. Future coordination with utilities is planned.
