A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Battle of Franklin Trust to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metro Parks and Recreation Department, to transfer a portrait of Frank McGavock and an inscribed silver spoon to the historical collection at Two Rivers Mansion.

WHEREAS, the Battle of Franklin Trust has awarded an in-kind grant with an estimated value of \$2,125.00 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metro Parks and Recreation Department, to transfer a portrait of Frank McGavock and an inscribed silver spoon to the historical collection at Two Rivers Mansion; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Battle of Franklin Trust, with an estimated value of \$2,125.00, and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metro Parks and Recreation Department, to transfer a portrait of Frank McGavock and an inscribed silver spoon to the historical collection at Two Rivers Mansion, a copy of which in-kind grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the portrait and inscribed silver spoon be appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

# BATTLE OF FRANKLIN TRUST

*Learn how the Civil War redefined America.*

March 20, 2026

On Tuesday, March 17, 2026, The Board of Directors of The Battle of Franklin Trust met for their regularly scheduled meeting. A recommendation for object transfer was reviewed at that time. The proposed transfer to Metro Nashville Parks of a portrait of Frank McGavock and a silver spoon inscribed "David and Willie" was reviewed. The recommendation was for these items to be deaccessioned from the collection of The Battle of Franklin Trust and transferred to the historical collection for Metro Nashville for inclusion in the collection at Two Rivers Mansion. The recommendation was discussed and approved with no opposition.

Copies of all paperwork, including provenance, files, and reports pertaining to the objects listed below will be provided by The Battle of Franklin Trust.

The Battle of Franklin Trust requests the Parks Board to accept an in-kind grant of these items to be placed in the collection at Two Rivers Mansion. The total estimated value of the in-kind grant is \$2,125.00. No money will be sent to Parks. There is no grant match or other obligations to Metro Government or Metro Parks related to this grant.

## **1979.2.5 Portrait of Frank McGavock**


Francis "Frank" Owen McGavock, the subject of the portrait, was the son of David H. McGavock and his wife Willie Elizabeth Harding.

The portrait, ca. 1851, is attributed to Washington B. Cooper, and it is currently insured for \$2000.

## **1999.3 Silver Olive Spoon**

The coin silver olive spoon is engraved "David & Willie" on the handle, and "from Cousin David" on the reverse of the handle. It is believed that the spoon could have been a wedding gift to David and Willie in 1851.

The spoon, ca. 1850-1855, is made by Bailey and Co, and has English silver hallmarks, and is currently insured for \$125.


