REQUEST FOR DONATION APPROVAL – MCCABE PARK LITTLE LEAGUE

Please accept this letter as McCabe Park Little League's ("MPLL") request to donate the following:

1. A new fence around the small baseball field located at McCabe Park.
2. New bases and field dressing for the infield of the baseball field at Elmington Park. The surface in its current state becomes very slippery after a light rain. Additionally, it remains wet and unplayable for hours after a rain.
3. Install gutters for the concession/restroom building and a French drain in that area at McCabe Park.

McCabe Park Little League reserves space from Metro Parks to provide two seasons of baseball to roughly 500 West Nashville youth ranging in age from four to twelve and hopes to continue improving and developing fields in order to better serve the community. These projects will allow for more practice and game space as our league continues to grow.

We anticipate work being completed after all necessary Metro Parks and Council approvals are granted. Importantly, no matching funds will be required from Metro Parks as McCabe Park Little League will cover all expenses associated with the development and subsequent upkeep and maintenance. We have included some additional information below about the league for your review and kindly request your approval of these donations. Should you have any additional questions, we would be happy to respond.

Short summary of the organization

McCabe Park Little League is a volunteer-led, non-profit organization that has served youth in the Sylvan Park neighborhood of Nashville TN since 1986. Operating under the charter of Little League, the board of directors, without paid staff, runs youth baseball divisions ranging from Tee Ball to Majors and our Challenger program (for special needs children ranging in age from four to twenty-two).

Over the last three decades, the organization has consistently served as a family-friendly, accepting, and safe place for kids of all ages and skill levels to find a home and a place to learn and play the great game of baseball. Children come from a diverse background of schools in the surrounding neighborhoods and learn to participate on teams organized with a focus on parity and community, not championships.

Short description of the proposed project and objectives

1. The new fence would enclose the playing area to keep the ball in play, keep young children and dogs from running onto the field during the games and would shrink the field of play to take out most of the uneven outfield area. There would be an eight-foot gate for maintenance equipment access. The value of the donation would be \$7,374.71 and the install would be completed by Frank Urroz Fence Company.
2. We used the baseball field at Elmington Park for games and practices for our fall season this year. The playing surface in the infield becomes very treacherous when wet. We'd like to mix in some field dressing to solidify the playing surface. Additionally, we'd like to donate and install new break-away bases. The value of this donation would be \$1,500.
3. Anytime it rains, water collects near the building and along the walkway making the surrounding grounds very muddy. This would allow the ability to redirect the water away from the path most commonly traveled by players, coaches, families and those using it for exercise. The value of this donation would be \$1,480. The gutters and French drain would be installed by The Best Gutter & Construction, LLC.

All of the costs associated with these projects will be funded by McCabe Park Little League and will require no matching funds from Metro Parks.
