AMENDMENT ONE OF GRANT CONTRACT 71551

This Grant Contract Amendment is made and entered by and between the State of Tennessee, Department of Finance and Administration, Office of Criminal Justice Programs, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee." It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Grant Contract section B.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - B.1. This Grant Contract shall be effective on 10/15/2021 ("Effective Date") and extend for a period of Twenty (20) months and fifteen (15) days after the Effective Date ("Term"). The State shall have no obligation to the Grantee for fulfillment of the Scope outside the Term.
- 2. The following is added as Grant Contract section B.2.:
 - B.2. Term Extension. It is understood and agreed that the State may extend the Term an additional period of time, not to exceed three hundred-sixty-five (365) days beyond the expiration date of this Grant Contract, under the same terms and conditions. In no event, however, shall the maximum Term, including all extensions or renewals, exceed a total of sixty (60) months.
- 3. The following is added as Grant Contract section E.6.
 - E.6. <u>State Sponsored Insurance</u>. The Grantee warrants that it will not enroll or permit its employees, officials, or employees of contractors to enroll or participate in a state sponsored health insurance plan through their employment, official, or contractual relationship with Grantee unless Grantee first demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Department of Finance and Administration that it and any contract entity satisfies the definition of a governmental or quasi-governmental entity as defined by federal law applicable to ERISA. Grantee must submit all required documentation to the Department of Finance and Administration and receive approval on or before July 1, 2023, to comply with this grant requirement.
- Grant Contract Attachment A-1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new attachment A-1 attached hereto.
- 5. Grant Contract Attachment B is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new attachment B attached hereto.

Required Approvals. The State is not bound by this Amendment until it is signed by the contract parties and approved by appropriate officials in accordance with applicable Tennessee laws and regulations (depending upon the specifics of this contract, said officials may include, but are not limited to, the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, the Commissioner of Human Resources, and the Comptroller of the Treasury).

<u>Amendment Effective Date</u>. The revisions set forth herein shall be effective August 31, 2022. All other terms and conditions of this Grant Contract not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
