On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of 105 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main, one sewer manhole, and easements and the acceptance of approximately 103 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), two sanitary sewer manholes, a sewer easement, 41 linear feet of six-inch water main (DIP), and one fire hydrant assembly to serve the Bordeaux Collaboration development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
