On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

*A request for permanent and temporary easements to construct Project 26-SWC-149, 1013 Maynor Avenue Public Utility Drainage Easement. These easements are to be acquired through negotiations, condemnation, and acceptance in order to complete this project.*
