On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request the abandonment of 373 linear feet of existing eight-inch sanitary sewer main and one sanitary sewer manhole, the replacement of approximately 15 linear feet of existing eight-inch sanitary sewer main, the rehabilitation of two sanitary sewer manholes, and the acceptance of approximately 115 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer mains (PVC), approximately 709 linear feet of new 12-inch sanitary sewer mains (PVC), and eight new sanitary sewer manholes to serve the Peabody Union development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
