The Nashville Downtown Partnership was created in 1994 as a private, nonprofit corporation dedicated to serving the businesses, employees, residents, and visitors of Music City's urban core. Through our work and partnerships, we ensure downtown Nashville is the clean, safe, and vibrant place where you work, shop, live, and do business.

The Nashville Downtown Partnership pursues its Core Purpose through:

- business recruitment and retention;
- residential and retail development;
- public space management;
- access and transportation;
- communications and marketing for downtown destinations.

These efforts are made possible through the work of the administrative and operations staff, Board of Directors, and many public and private partners. The Partnership administers these services in two Business Improvement Districts (BID): The Central Business Improvement District (CBID) and The Gulch Business Improvement District (GBID).

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### Request for Authorization to Accept Departmental Donation

**Note:** Pursuant to the Metropolitan Code, all departments, boards and commissions may accept and expend gifts/donations (Unconditional or unrestricted, from the perspective of the donor, transfer of assets) valued at \$5,000 or less.

Gifts and donations valued above \$5,000 to all departments, except those specifically granted authority to accept gifts/donations as authorized in the Metro Code; may be accepted and authorized for expenditure by Metro Council via a Resolution. Grants or conditional/restricted gifts or gifts requiring formal conditions or contracts may require additional consideration and review. Refer to Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Finance Department Policy: #42 for additional guidance.

**Instructions:** An employee of the department requesting to accept an unconditional unrestricted gift to the department or otherwise on behalf of the department shall complete this form for review and approval prior to formal acceptance of the gift or donation.
