It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. The following is added as Grant Contract Section E.4.:
 - E.4. <u>Grantee Name.</u> All references to "Metro Historical Commission" shall be deleted and replaced with "Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County".
- Grant Contract Edison Vendor ID changed from 0000172670 to 0000000004.
- 3. Grant Contract section A.2.d is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - A.2. d. The person employed by the Grantee to complete the survey and National Register nomination for the property at 2614 Jefferson Street, currently known as Elk's Lodge #1102 and historically as the Club Baron shall meet the following qualifications: A graduate degree in history, historic preservation, architectural history, architecture, or a closely related field' or a bachelor's degree in one of these plus one of the following: (a) at least two years of full-time experience in research, writing, teaching, interpretation, or other demonstrable professional activity with an academic institution or (b) substantial contribution through research and publication to the body of scholarly knowledge in one of these fields.
- 4. Contract section B. TERM OF CONTRACT is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - B. TERM OF CONTRACT:
 - This Grant Contract shall be effective on October 1, 2023 ("Effective Date") and extend for a period of twenty-four (24) months after the Effective Date ("Term"). The State shall have no obligation to the Grantee for fulfillment of the Scope outside the Term.
- 5. Grant Contract Attachment One is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new Attachment One attached hereto.
- 6. Grant Contract Attachment Two is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new Attachment Two attached hereto.
