Dear Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation,

The Hillsboro-West End Neighborhood Association (HWEN) requests the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation (Metro Parks) to accept a cash grant not to exceed \$20,000 for the 2024 annual maintenance and repair costs of the mosaic "Sea Serpent" sculpture (commonly referred to as "the dragon") at Fannie-Mae Dees Park (2400 Blakemore Avenue).

As a recap, Metro Parks commissioned the sculpture as a community art project for Fannie Mae Dees Park in the late 1970s. Over time it fell into disrepair and underwent two major restorations. The latest restoration was a partnership by Metro Parks and HWEN in 2016-2018, culminating in a grand reopening in May 2018. Since then, HWEN recognized the need for and began funding the annual maintenance needed to prevent it from falling into disrepair again.

However, HWEN's permissions from Metro Parks granted in 2017 to work on the dragon have now expired. In light of this, HWEN and Metro Parks have established an annual maintenance agreement to ensure the sculpture is properly maintained. Metro Parks will oversee and manage the maintenance by Art Up, and HWEN will fund the work. HWEN has approved Art Up's 2024 proposal, as summarized below, and will fund inspection, restoration and maintenance costs of up to \$20,000.

HWEN's Board of Directors have requested and approved Art Up Nashville's (vendor) 2024 Annual Maintenance Scope of Work and proposal for cleaning and restoration of the sculpture from the Annual Inspection of the Sea Serpent sculpture.

Annual Inspection Cost: \$1,006 Scope of Work Cost: \$16,366

Contingency: \$1,737

Total: \$19,109

This grant requires no match from Metro Parks. This project will be fully funded by the Hillsboro-West End Neighborhood Association. The association will provide Metro Parks with the cash grant to pay the vendor Art Up Nashville for their services rendered.

We are in communication with the Metro Parks Staff on this proposed project and will continue to work with them on any further details of the project and schedule as the project moves forward. HWEN and Art Up Nashville will work with Metro Parks on scheduling and communication for the public the duration of this project. We would like to start within one month of gaining approval from the Metro Parks. We are aware that this will include time to notify the public of the temporary closure for this part of the park as needed to complete the restoration project. The timeframe to complete the cleaning and restoration will be approximately 4-5 weeks, contingent upon weather and availability of materials.

Thank you for the opportunity to work in partnership with Metro Parks for the benefit of Nashville's iconic "dragon" sculpture, Fannie Mae Dees Park, and the city.

The Hillsboro-West End Neighborhood Association (HWEN) have established an annual Maintenance Agreement with Metro Parks to ensure the Sea Serpent (Dragon) sculpture at Fannie Mae Dees Park is properly maintained.

On September 3, 2024, the details of the Maintenance Agreement were presented to the Parks Board and approved by the Board. The terms of the agreement are as follows:

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

- 1) Each Spring, the Hillsboro-West End Neighborhood Association (HWEN) will work with Art Up to inspect the dragon sculpture and determine the maintenance work that needs to be completed. Art Up will then provide HWEN with a proposal including costs for the annual maintenance work.
- 2) After this, HWEN will present a grant letter and request acceptance by Metro Parks of a cash grant to cover the costs of maintenance to be completed within the next fiscal year. Due to the materials used and heat experienced each Summer, the annual maintenance work will not be performed until Fall each year.
- 3) There is no cash match or other obligation to Metro Parks.
- 4) Once the grant is approved by Parks Board and Metro Council, HWEN will send a check to Metro Parks for work to be completed within the next fiscal year. The funds will be deposited in a special Business Unit which will be reserved for the annual maintenance expenses.
- 5) All maintenance work will be managed and approved by Metro Parks staff.
- 6) Metro Parks will pay Art Up directly for the maintenance services rendered.
