An ordinance to amend the Geographic Information Systems Street and Alley Centerline Layer for The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County by renaming Tuliptree Court as “Tulip Tree Court” and renaming Tuliptree Lane as “Tulip Tree Lane”, south of Poplar Creek Trace (Proposal Number 2021M-006SR-001).




Figure 1: Poplar Creek Estates, Phase 1, 1985. Source: Register of Deeds (image cropped).

The subject roads, Tuliptree Court and Tuliptree Lane, appear on the Plan of Subdivision for Phase 1 of Poplar Creek Estates, recorded in Plat Book 6250, page 647 on September 25, 1985 (Figure 1). According to the Assessor of Property, the four residences with Tuliptree Court addresses were constructed in 1986 and the sixteen residences with Tuliptree Lane addresses were constructed in 1986 and 1987. Phase 1 of the Poplar Creek Estates development included several streets with tree-inspired names, such as Willow Oak Drive, Sweetgum Lane, Sweetgum Court, Hollow Tree Court, and Sugar Maple Lane.
