The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately 714 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP), approximately 748 linear feet of new three-inch sanitary sewer force main (PVC), approximately 99 linear feet of new four-inch sanitary sewer force main (PVC,) two new fire hydrant assemblies and four new epoxy coated sanitary sewer manholes, for property located at Earhart Road (unnumbered), also known as Earhart Subdivision Phase 1, and offsite of the project location at the southwest corner of New John Hager Road and Earhart Drive, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.


