A resolution to approve the Third Amendment to a grant contract for constructing affordable housing approved by RS2022-1857 between The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Woodbine Community Organization, Inc.

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County ("Metro"), acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, previously entered into a grant contract with Woodbine Community Organization, Inc., for the express purpose of constructing affordable housing approved by RS2022-1857; and,

WHEREAS, Metro, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Woodbine Community Organization, Inc. executed a First Amendment to said grant contract to add a property address to the contract, approved by RS2023-2168; and,

WHEREAS, Metro, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Woodbine Community Organization, Inc. executed a Second Amendment to said grant contract to extend the term of the agreement and increase the number of housing units, approved by RS2024-711; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend this grant contract by extending the term of the contract to 48 months and to amend the draw schedule, a copy of which amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that the amendment to the grant contract be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That this Third Amendment to the grant contract for constructing affordable housing between The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Woodbine Community Organization, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

AMENDMENT #3 TO GRANT CONTRACT BETWEEN

THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY BY AND THROUGH

THE METROPOLITAN HOUSING TRUST FUND COMMISSION AND

WOODBINE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION

This contract amendment is entered into by and between THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE METROPOLITAN HOUSING TRUST FUND COMMISSION, a municipal corporation of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter referred to as "Metro") and WOODBINE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION (hereinafter referred to as "Recipient"). It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract approved is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Grant Contract section B.1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - **B.1.** Grant Contract Term. The term of this Grant shall be from execution of the grant agreement until Project completion, but in no way greater than 48 months from the execution of the grant agreement. Metro shall have no obligation for services rendered by the Recipient which are not performed within this term.
- 2. Grant contract section C.3a is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

a. Grant Draws

Before a draw can be made, there must be a physical inspection of the project by Metro or an approved designee unless otherwise specified. The inspection must confirm appropriate completion of the project.

- 12.5% Upon receipt of the building permit, proof of builders risk insurance with Metro Nashville listed as a lien holder
- 25% Documented predevelopment costs
- 20% Footing, framing, and foundation complete
- 20% Plumbing, electrical, and mechanical roughed-in, inspected, and passed by Metro Codes; roofing complete
- 10% Doors, cabinets, countertops, drywall, trim installed
- 12.5% Receipt of final Use and Occupancy letter from Metro Codes

All draw requests except the first 12.5% draw and 25% for predevelopment costs must be inspected before funding.

The remaining provisions of the Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
