Dear Members of the Parks Board,

Greenways for Nashville (GfN) requests approval to provide in-kind improvements to 7 trailheads on the Stones River Greenway and 3 trailheads on the Whites Creek Greenway. GfN will contract directly with the vendors and all work will be done to Parks Department's specifications. The project is expected to last up to 6 months. The value of the work is \$75,000 and there would be no matching cost to Metro.

The scope is to include repaint, retrofit framing, update wayfinding graphics, replace trash cans, repaint pavement striping, and repair benches and other enhancements to bring these trailheads to like-new condition.


