On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to amend Council BL2021-1020 and Proposal No. 2021M-082ES-001 for the purpose of abandoning an additional 229 linear feet of 30-inch water main, 150 linear feet of 6-inch water main and easements, and to accept an additional 88 linear feet of 30-inch water main (DIP), 567 linear feet of 8-inch water main (DIP), the relocation of two fire hydrant assemblies and easements to serve the Reservoir Zone 4A development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
