RE: NOTICE OF NASHVILLE MUSIC, FILM, & ENTERTAINMENT COMMISSION VACANCIES

Notice is hereby given of **three vacancies** on the Nashville Music, Film, and Entertainment Commission of the Metropolitan Government which, pursuant to <u>Second Substitute Ordinance No. BL2022-1631</u>, adopted April 18, 2023, are to be filled by Metropolitan Council election. These vacancies are the result of the expirations of the terms of two Nashville Music, Film, and Entertainment Commission members – Ms. Stephanie Silverman and Mr. Shannon Sanders – on June 20, 2024, and one existing Councilnominated vacancy on the commission. Members of the Nashville Music, Film, and Entertainment Commission serve terms lasting four years.

The procedure for filling vacancies on this commission is set forth in Council Rule No. 50. The timeframe for this process will be as follows:

- This memorandum shall constitute notice to all members of the Metropolitan Council of **three** vacancies.
- Members of the Council will be called upon to make nominations at the regular Council meeting on June 18, 2024, to fill the vacancies.
- Nominees will be notified to meet with the Council's Rules, Confirmations, and Public Elections
  Committee on Tuesday, July 2, 2024. Any nominee who does not appear before the Rules
  Committee on July 2, 2024, shall be deemed to have withdrawn their name from nomination.
- An election to fill the vacancies will be conducted at the July 16, 2024 Council meeting. It is not required for the nominee to be present on the evening of the election, but they are very welcome.
