BRANDYWINE VILLAGE MEDICAL OFFICE BUILDING (MOB) PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between <u>A-Team Properties, LLC</u>., hereinafter known as "<u>A-TEAM</u>", and The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County acting through the Metropolitan Department of Water and Sewerage Services, hereinafter known as "<u>METRO</u>".

WHEREAS, both A-TEAM and METRO desire to provide improved public sanitary sewer service for both its proposed development as well as the existing properties in this area; and

WHEREAS, A-TEAM has been approved to serve its development BRANDYWINE VILLAGE MOB; known as Project No. 23-SL-0182, and

WHEREAS, the provision of such sanitary sewer service will directly benefit both parties and the general community of Nashville and Davidson County. Tennessee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, A-TEAM AND METRO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

I. SCOPE OF WORK:

A project consisting of the lining of approximately 185 linear feet of existing 12-inch sewer main (DIP) and the rehabilitation of 3 sanitary sewer manholes to serve the development located at 616 Brandywine Village Court.

II. PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- A. <u>METRO</u> will contract and oversee construction of this project, and the design shall meet all METRO specifications and requirements including telemetry and any required repeater sites.
- B. METRO will inspect the construction and will be responsible for ongoing operation and maintenance.
- C. <u>A-TEAM's</u> level of participation is based on a determination by METRO utilizing a benefit/cost analysis to the project area's existing customer base and overall systemic operational needs. For this specific project, <u>A-TEAM</u> agrees to pay \$24,939.00 as a contribution towards these improvements. Furthermore, <u>A-TEAM</u> understands that their proposed development will not be issued a permit for connections to the public sanitary sewer system until this payment has been received.
- D. This agreement is subject to the approval through Resolution (one reading) of The Metropolitan Council of Nashville and Davidson County.

III. FUTURE AMENDMENTS:

Any future amendments to this agreement shall be approved by resolution of the Metropolitan Council.
