ORDINANCE NO. BL2025-819

Madam President,

I move to amend Ordinance No. BL2025-819 as follows:

I. By Amending Section 8 as follows:

Section 8. That Section 10.20.395 Annual Report, shall be amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

10.20.395 - Periodic reports

A. Annual Report. Every person collecting, hauling, disposing of waste and recovered materials, and/or any person providing permanent or temporary disposal of waste, and/or any person processing waste covered by this article, shall provide the director an annual report stating the amount of tons of waste collected, hauled, disposed and/or processed by said person, as a condition of this permitted activity. The director may require said person to submit said report through a certified independent audit firm.

B. Quarterly Recycling performance report. Each quarter, the director shall submit a written performance report to the Council regarding solid waste disposal, recycling, and compost performance. The quarterly written performance report shall address the following:

1. Operations, and cost monitoring and management metrics, including, at a minimum, the following data for the preceding quarter, stated in comparison to comparable data for the quarter prior to the immediately preceding quarter:

- a. The number of active convenience center customers;
- b. Total waste tonnage;
- c. Total recycling tonnage;
- d. Total cost per ton of trash collected; and
- e. Total cost per ton of recycling collected.

2. Recycling. The report must also include information on recycling collected and processed:

- a. The percentage of recycling collected that was rejected as contaminated;
- b. The categories of recycled materials;
- c. The quantity, in tons, of each category processed; and
- d. The destination(s) of each category of recycle material – state and end product.

3. Compost. The report must also include the tonnage of compost collected through the current compost pilot program or any successor program under Metro's responsibility.

II. By deleting Section 9 in its entirety and renumbering the subsequent Section accordingly.
