 - Continuation of invasive plant removal in partnership with Invasive Plant Control, Inc. throughout the 3,200 acres of Warner Parks.
 - Planting of an estimated 5,000 native seedlings throughout the park.
 - Planting of any trees funded through Metro will be submitted to Metro for review and approval prior to planting.
 - Planting of landscape trees will be submitted to Metro for review and approval prior to planting.
 - Consistent with prior year, planting plans will be submitted to Metro as season progresses.
