ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 2 (MWS Project No. 25-SL-133 and Proposal No. 2025M-129ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 897 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), five sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 2, is needed to construct Project No. 25-SL-133; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2025M-129ES-001 on August 7, 2025, for the acceptance of said sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately 897 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), five sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 2, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.


