On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to amend Council ordinance BL2023-1700 and Proposal No. 2022M-188ES-001 for the purpose of abandoning approximately 410 linear feet of 12-inch sanitary sewer main and approximately 617 linear feet of six-inch water main. Specific infrastructure instead now will be the abandonment of approximately 410 linear feet of 12-inch sanitary sewer main and approximately 617 linear feet of six-inch water main, and the acceptance of approximately 20 linear feet of six-inch public water main (DIP), one fire hydrant assembly, approximately 40 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), and one sanitary sewer manhole to serve the Modera SoBro Phase 1 development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.


