We are pleased to extend support for Metro Public Health Department’s participation in the Data Across Sectors for Health (DASH) Mentor Program as one of the four collaborative awardees for the Nashville PrEP Coalition.

The DASH Mentor Program is designed to support the development and deepening of multi-sector collaborations by supporting Mentees to:

- connect and collaborate with knowledgeable, well-connected national leaders in the data-sharing space;
- access real time peer learning community tackling similar issues and experimenting with new approaches collectively;
- participate in virtual convenings and meetings to share knowledge and experience;
- explore, experiment, and plan a data sharing strategy; and
- enable and encourage opportunities for peer learning in the All In learning collaborative.

This grant is effective April 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

Metro Public Health Department will receive \$2,500, issued as two separate payments. The first payment of \$2,000 will be sent to Metro Public Health Department upon the receipt of funds from the DASH Mentor program and upon acknowledgement of receipt of this letter. The second payment will be distributed once payment is received by the First Response Clinic at the end of the mentorship program. The funds are primarily intended to support staff participation in the Mentor program activities (check-in calls, webinars, etc.). Funds can also be used to support attendance at national conferences, such as the CIE Summit hosted by San Diego 2-1-1, or others as recommended by the Mentor. Other acceptable uses of funds include: paying for online trainings or events or stipends for community members to participate in collaborative activities.
