On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of easement rights for a portion of an unnamed street extending between Riverside Drive and CSX Railroad (formerly Waters Avenue) that was closed by Metro Ordinance BL 065-656 with easements retained. Requesting for those easement rights for this parcel to be abandoned.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
