An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new public sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manhole and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 3, (MWS Project No. 25-SL-134 and Proposal No. 2025M-131ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 121 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), one sanitary sewer manhole and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 3, is needed to construct project number 25-SL-134; and,


