AMENDMENT FOUR OF CONTRACT 70037

This Amendment is made and entered by and between the State of Tennessee, Department of Human Services, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County – Parental Assistance Court, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor." For good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, it is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject contract is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Contract Section A.2. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - A.2. The Tennessee Department of Human Services is committed to a Two-Generation ("2Gen") Approach, which requires intentional focus on the success of the children and adults in their lives simultaneously and places the family on a better path towards economic security when the needs of the family are addressed holistically.

The 2Gen Approach includes an emphasis on education, economic supports, health and wellbeing, and social capital. This goal shall be achieved in the context of strengthening community planning and coordinating efforts, organizing services to help families achieve economic security, and developing innovative approaches to attacking the causes and effects of poverty for low-income families that are recipients of or eligible for public assistance.

- 2. Contract Section A.3. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - A.3. The Contractor shall provide opportunities for and meet the needs of low-income and/or under-employed non-custodial parents and their families who are subject to a current child support order, using the Two-Generation Approach. Based on Tennessee's four (4) core components of the Two-Generation Approach (i.e., education, economic supports, health and well-being, and social capital), the Contractor shall provide services that align with and address the following components:
 - a. Workforce Development and Economic Assets. Improve the economic self-sufficiency of the family through financial literacy and asset-building programs to achieve financial independence. Increase the enrollment of parents in an adult education program, postsecondary program, and/or technical/ vocational training program to increase employment skills.
 - b. Health and Well-Being. Improve conflict resolutions and communication skills. Improve the families' ability to manage stress, recognize maladaptive responses, and use positive parenting approaches.
 - c. Social Capital. Improve formal and informal networks of family, friends, neighbors, and community agencies to help families develop meaningful connections. Increase and sustain community partnerships that support the program. Improve community involvement and civic engagement.
- 3. Contract Section A.14. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - A.14. The Contractor shall provide a list of all program participants to the Davidson County Child Support Office, and request that the Non-Custodial Parent Resource ("NCPR") screen in the Tennessee Child Support Enforcement System ("TCSES") be updated with a Y indicator, so

each non-custodial parent is identified as participating in the Parental Assistance Court Program.

4. Contract Section A.15. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

A.15. Reserved.

- 5. Contract Section A.16. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - A.16. The Contractor may no longer engage with program participants that are enrolled but fail to respond or participate in the program within sixty (60) days of the enrollment effective date. If a program participant is removed from the program, the Contractor shall notify the Davidson County Child Support office to have the Y indicator on the NCPR screen updated to N to reflect the end of the participation.
- 6. Contract Section A.17. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following

A.17. Reserved.

7. Contract Section A.18. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

A.18. Reserved.

8. Contract Section A.19. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

A.19. Reserved.

- 9. Contract Section B.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - B.1. This Contract shall be effective for the period beginning on July 1, 2021 ("Effective Date") and ending on June 30, 2026 ("Term"). The State shall have no obligation for goods or services provided by the Contractor prior to the Effective Date.
- 10. Contract Section B.2. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - B.2. <u>Renewal Options</u>. This Contract may be renewed upon satisfactory completion of the Term. The State reserves the right to execute up to zero (0) renewal options under the same terms and conditions for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months each by the State, at the State's sole option. In no event, however, shall the maximum Term, including all renewals or extensions, exceed a total of sixty (60) months.
- 11. Contract Section B.3. is deleted in its entirety.
- 12. Contract Section C.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - C.1. <u>Maximum Liability</u>. In no event shall the maximum liability of the State under this Contract exceed one million four hundred eighty-seven thousand eight hundred thirty-eight dollars eighty-four cents (\$1,487,838.84). This amount shall constitute the entire compensation due the Contractor for all service and Contractor obligations hereunder regardless of the difficulty, hours worked, or materials or equipment required. The Contract Amount includes, but is not limited to, all applicable taxes, fees, overhead, profit, and all other direct and indirect costs incurred or to be incurred by the Contractor.
- 13. Contract Section C.3. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - C.3. The Contractor shall be reimbursed for actual, reasonable, and necessary costs based upon the Contract Budget, not to exceed the Maximum Liability established in Section C.1. Upon progress toward the completion of the Scope, as described in Section A of this Contract, the Contractor shall submit invoices prior to any reimbursement of allowable costs. The Contract

Budget, attached and incorporated hereto as Attachments A and A-1, shall constitute the maximum amount due the Contractor under this Contract. The Contract Budget line-items include, but are not limited to, all applicable taxes, fees, overhead, and all other direct and indirect costs incurred or to be incurred by the Contractor that are allowable.

- 14. Contract Section E.2. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - E.2. <u>Communications and Contacts</u>. All instructions, notices, consents, demands, or other communications required or contemplated by this Contract shall be in writing and shall be made by certified, first class mail, return receipt requested and postage prepaid, by overnight courier service with an asset tracking system, or by EMAIL or facsimile transmission with recipient confirmation. Any such communications, regardless of method of transmission, shall be addressed to the respective party at the appropriate mailing address, facsimile number, or EMAIL address as set forth below or to that of such other party or address, as may be hereafter specified by written notice.
