Resolution No. _____

A resolution accepting a grant from the Nashville Police + Public Safety Alliance to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department, to fund the testing of sexual assault kits by an outside laboratory or laboratories to improve effectiveness in evidence processing through appropriate outsourcing.

WHEREAS, the Nashville Police + Public Safety Alliance has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$107,000 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department, to fund the testing of sexual assault kits by an outside laboratory or laboratories to improve effectiveness in evidence processing through appropriate outsourcing; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between the Nashville Police + Public Safety Alliance, with an estimated value not to exceed \$107,000, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department, to fund the testing of sexual assault kits by an outside laboratory or laboratories to improve effectiveness in evidence processing through appropriate outsourcing, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

SECOND GRANT LETTER

Grantor: The Nashville Police + Public Safety Alliance

Grantee: The Metropolitan Government, by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department

WHEREAS, the Nashville Police + Public Safety Alliance (“Alliance”) supports the goal of the MNPD Crime Lab to improve effectiveness in evidence processing through appropriate outsourcing and continuous improvements in technology and equipment at the MNPD Crime Lab to create sustainability in evidence processing, therefore:

Section 1. Grant. The Alliance grants to the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department (MNPD), a municipal corporation exempt from federal income tax, the additional amount of \$107,000 to fund the testing of sexual assault kits by an outside laboratory or laboratories during the grant term, subject to the terms provided herein.

Section 2. Grant Term. This Grant shall be effective for the period commencing on January 16, 2026, and ending on January 16, 2027. The Alliance shall have no obligation for funding any laboratory testing that is conducted outside the specified period.


Section 3. Payment of Grant. The Alliance will pay the Second Grant in full to MNPD in the amount of \$107,000 upon receipt of the signed Second Grant Letter with documentation regarding the name of the outside laboratory provider or providers selected to perform the testing in accordance with the Metropolitan Code of Laws and all other applicable statutes, rules and regulations.

Section 4. Purpose of Grant. MNPD agrees to use the Second Grant solely for the testing of sexual assault kits by an outside laboratory or laboratories.


Section 5. Indirect Costs. No indirect costs are allowable. All funds are to be program direct.

Section 6. Reporting. On or before January 16, 2027, and upon request, MNPD will provide a report to the Alliance showing how the funds from the First and Second Grants have been expended and specifying the number of sexual assault kits that remain to be tested.
