

RESOLUTION NO. RS2020 - 595

A resolution approving an amendment to an assignment and assumption grant agreement amendment of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) grant between the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the Metropolitan Development and Housing Agency (MDHA) to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Social Services Department/Homelessness Commission, to contribute to the national effort to end homelessness.

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Social Services Department/Homelessness Commission, previously entered into an assignment and assumption grant agreement amendment with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to contribute to the national effort to end homelessness approved by RS2019-1791; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the assignment and assumption grant agreement amendment to extend the end date from June 30, 2020 to October 31, 2020, a copy of which amendment is attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant amendment be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the amendment to the assignment and assumption grant agreement amendment of the Homeless Management Information System grant between MDHA and The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Social Services Commission, to contribute to the national effort to end homelessness, a copy of which amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.


Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

**SPECIAL COVID-19 AMENDMENT TO THE  
CONTINUUM OF CARE PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT**

This Amendment to Grant Agreement is made by and between the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County, (the Recipient).

**RECITALS**

1. HUD and the Recipient entered into a Grant Agreement dated 07/01/2019, having Grant No. TN0060L4J041811 (the Grant Agreement).
2. The parties are desirous of amending the Grant Agreement to add eligible activities and to shift funds between eligible activities in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
3. HUD has determined that the change is necessary to better serve eligible persons within the geographic area and to ensure that the priorities established under the Notice of Funding Availability in which the grant was originally awarded, or the most recent NOFA, are met.
4. The parties are desirous of amending the Grant Agreement to allow Recipients to extend the term of the Grant Agreement ending 06/30/2020 and permit Recipient to use funds that would have been unspent at the end of the original term for eligible costs that respond to unique program participant needs arising from the COVID-19 pandemic.
5. The need for the assistance provided by the project continues to exist within the jurisdiction where the project is located.
6. HUD has reviewed the performance of the Recipient and has determined that the grant funds remaining at the end of term should not be deobligated.

**AGREEMENTS**

The Grant Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. The term of the Grant Agreement is extended through October 31, 2020.

This Amendment to Grant Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties as to amendment of the Grant Agreement and will become effective only upon the execution hereof by all parties. The remaining terms of the Grant Agreement remain in full force and effect. The parties, on the dates set forth below their respective signatures, hereby execute this Amendment to Grant Agreement, as follows:
