On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 343 linear feet of eight-inch water main (DIP), one fire hydrant assembly and approximately 21 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), one sanitary sewer manhole and the acceptance of approximately 647 linear feet of eight-inch water main (DIP), one fire hydrant assembly and one sanitary sewer manhole and any associated easements to serve the Novel Richland Creek development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, General Services-Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
