An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new sanitary sewer mains, sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 4 (MWS Project No. 25-SL-135 and Proposal No. 2025M-130ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 321 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), approximately 46 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), two sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at Nesbitt Lane (unnumbered), also known as 253 Nesbitt Phase 4, is needed to construct Project No. 25-SL-135; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2025M-130ES-001 on August 7, 2025, for the acceptance of said sanitary sewer mains, sanitary sewer manholes and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. 
