RE: NOTICE OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMISSION VACANCY

Notice is hereby given of one vacancy on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission of the Metropolitan Government which, pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 2.153.020, is to be filled by Metropolitan Council election. This vacancy is the result of the establishment of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission by the passage of Ordinance No. BL2023-1882, as amended. Initial members of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission are appointed for staggered terms of two, three, and four years dated from the effective date of BL2023-1882, as amended. The vacancy to be filled by Metropolitan Council election is for an initial term of three years.

The procedure for filling the vacancy on this commission is set forth in Council Rule No. 50. The timeframe for this process will be as follows:

- This memorandum shall constitute notice to all members of the Metropolitan Council of one vacancy.
- Members of the Council will be called upon to make nominations at the regular Council meeting on April 2, 2024, to fill the vacancy.
- Nominees will be notified to meet with the Council's Rules, Confirmations, and Public Elections
 Committee on Tuesday, April 16, 2024, and an election to fill the vacancy will be conducted at the
 Council meeting that evening. Any nominee who does not appear before the Rules Committee on
 April 16, 2024, shall be deemed to have withdrawn their name from nomination.
