WHEREAS, the Centennial Park Conservancy has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$1,732,140.57 with a required cash match of \$250,000.00 to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, for the construction of the Children's Memory Garden in Centennial Park, a copy of which grant is attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between the Centennial Park Conservancy, in an amount not to exceed \$1,732,140.57, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, for the construction of the Children's Memory Garden in Centennial Park, a copy of which grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this grant be appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.


Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Metro Parks Board Members,

Centennial Park Conservancy requests Parks Board approval of a grant in the amount of \$1,732,140.57 for the construction of the Children's Memory Garden in Centennial Park.

Our understanding is that Metro Parks has previously committed \$250,000.00 as a match to assist with project expenses.

The Children's Memory Garden will be located in a two-acre area immediately north of the existing playground. It will replace the existing memorial that was developed by volunteers starting in the 1990s and which is sometimes referred to as the Children's Victims of Violence Memorial. The new memorial, designed by Nelson Byrd Woltz Landscape Architects, will feature sculptural granite benches that form two gathering spaces, artistic lighting, a "lighthouse" structure that will hold the name plaques from the earlier monument, walkways, and approximately 25 new trees. The project is consistent with the *Centennial Park Concept Plan*.

We are in communication with Metro Parks staff who have reviewed and approved all proposed projects and will continue to work with them on the details of plans, materials, and scheduling as projects move forward.
