On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for approval to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for approval for the abandonment of approximately 363 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC) and easements, and the acceptance of approximately 70 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), three sanitary sewer manholes, one fire hydrant assembly and easements to serve the Donelson Library development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance - Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
