**RE:** NOTICE OF HISTORICAL COMMISSION VACANCY

Notice is hereby given of one vacancy on the Historical Commission of the Metropolitan Government. Pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 2.128.030, this vacancy is to be filled by Metropolitan Council election. This vacancy is the result of the expiration of the term of one Historical Commission member – Celso T. Castilho– as of August 10, 2025. Members of the Historical Commission serve terms lasting four years.

The procedure for filling vacancies on this board is set forth in Council Rule No. 50. The timeframe for this process will be as follows:

- This memorandum shall constitute notice to all members of the Council of **one vacancy**.
- **Members of the Council will be called upon to make nominations at the regular Council meeting on August 19, 2025, to fill the vacancy.**
- Nominees will be notified to meet with the Council's Rules, Confirmations, and Public Elections Committee on Tuesday, September 2, 2025. Any nominee who does not appear before the Rules Committee on September 2, 2025, shall be deemed to have withdrawn their name from nomination.
- An election to fill the vacancies will be conducted at the September 16, 2025, Council meeting. It is not required for a nominee to be present on the evening of the election, but they are very welcome to attend.
