RESOLUTION NO. _____

A resolution approving Amendment Number 5 to an intergovernmental agreement by and between the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation ("TDOT") and the Metropolitan Government, by and through the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure ("NDOT"), for the acceptance of work in connection with the construction of a sidewalk on Lebanon Pike, from McGavock Pike to Old Lebanon Pike. (Federal Project No. STP-M-24(60); State Project No.19LPLM-F3-130; PIN 121729.00; Prop. No.(2026M-045AG-001).

WHEREAS, RS2015-1535 approved an intergovernmental agreement between TDOT and NDOT for Lebanon Pike sidewalk improvements (the "Agreement"); and,

WHEREAS, RS2020-512 approved Amendment Number 1 to the Agreement, which replaced in its entirety the language of the Agreement, with the language of Amendment Number 1; and,

WHEREAS, RS2022-1433 approved Amendment Number 2 to the Agreement, which extended the completion date of the project to May 31, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, RS2024-421 approved Amendment Number 3 to the Agreement, which replaced Exhibit A to the Agreement in its entirety with a new Exhibit A that reflected the change in project costs and extended the project completion date to June 30, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, RS2024-837 approved Amendment Number 4 to the Agreement, which replaced Exhibit A to the Agreement in its entirety with a new Exhibit A that reflects a change in project costs; and,

WHEREAS, as set forth in Amendment Number 5 to the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, the parties now desire to extend the project completion date to May 31, 2029; and,

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 12-9-104(a)(2)(b) authorizes the Metropolitan Council to approve an agreement with TDOT by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that Amendment Number 5 to the Agreement be approved.

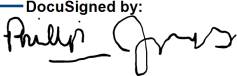
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That Amendment Number 5 to the intergovernmental agreement between the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation and the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, by and through the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That any amendments, renewals, or extension of the terms of the agreement may be approved by resolution of the Metropolitan Council.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

THIS AGREEMENT AMENDMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20____ by and between the STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, an agency of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter called the "Department") and the METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY (hereinafter called the "Agency"), for the purpose of providing an understanding among the parties of their respective obligations related to the management of the project described as:

SR-24 (Lebanon Pike), from McGavock Pike to Old Lebanon Pike in Nashville

1. The language of Agreement # 150066 A3 dated June 24, 2024 Section B.2 a) is hereby deleted in its entirety.
2. The following is added as B.2 a) .

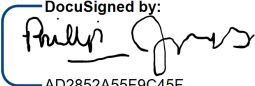
B.2 a) The Agency agrees to complete the herein assigned phases of the Project on or before **May 31, 2029**. If the Agency does not complete the herein described phases of the Project within this time period, this Agreement will expire on the last day of scheduled completion as provided in this paragraph unless an extension of the time period is requested by the Agency and granted in writing by the Department prior to the expiration of the Agreement. An extension of the term of this Agreement will be effected through an amendment to the Agreement. Expiration of this Agreement will be considered termination of the Project. The cost of any work performed after the expiration date of the Agreement will not be reimbursed by the Department.

All provisions of the original contract not expressly amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.
