

Contract Amendment Memo

Contract # L-4795 between the Metropolitan

Government of Nashville Davidson County and Dymon in the Rough

November 12, 2021

Subject: This amendment aims to provide additional funding to DYMON in the Rough to help cover the costs for afterschool transportation provided to the students at Lead Brick Church school.

Context: NAZA funds afterschool programs for middle school youth in Davidson County by partnering with local non-profit organizations to deliver free and high-quality programming focusing on holistic development of youth. Acknowledging the access and attendance barrier created by limited transportation, NAZA pays for transportation to help improve the access and safety of children and youth in afterschool programs.

Description: Some of the NAZA-funded program sites get access to MNPS buses based on their request and NAZA pays directly to MNPS for all buses at the rate of \$175 per day for evening transportation.

This year, due to the shortage of MNPS buses, a NAZA-funded partner, Dymon in the Rough, that serves youth from charter school (Lead Brick Church) did not have access to MNPS buses and had to arrange charter bus service using Gray Line. To ensure equal access to NAZA funds for transportation, NAZA offered to share the transportation cost for that program site by subsidizing the cost at \$175 daily rate (same rate we pay MNPS buses).

Since this expense was not budgeted as part of partner's Metro budget for 2021-2022 school year, we hereby request an amendment to the budget of Dymon in the Rough, Metro contract #L-4795 for the amount of up to \$24,500 to be used for the period of September 2021 through May 2022.

This program serves estimated 20 youth.

Acknowledging the access and attendance barrier created by limited transportation, NAZA pays for transportation to help improve the access and safety of children and youth in afterschool programs.

Description: Some of the NAZA-funded program sites get access to MNPS buses based on their request and NAZA pays directly to MNPS for all buses at the rate of \$175 per day for evening transportation.
