# **2024 Art Sentry Project Overview - The Parthenon**



## Art Sentry: Project Need

Over the last few years, Parthenon museum staff, docents, and leadership have observed a noticeable increase in concerning visitor/object interactions throughout the museum. With a small staff and only a single security guard assigned to the front entrance, the Parthenon team does not have the necessary personnel required to monitor all sensitive areas of the museum in real time.

After consultation with others in the field, including with friends at the Frist Art Museum, the staff has vetted and selected Art Sentry as the solution to protect the museum's assets, support its limited staff, and ultimately enable the museum team to focus more on customer service.



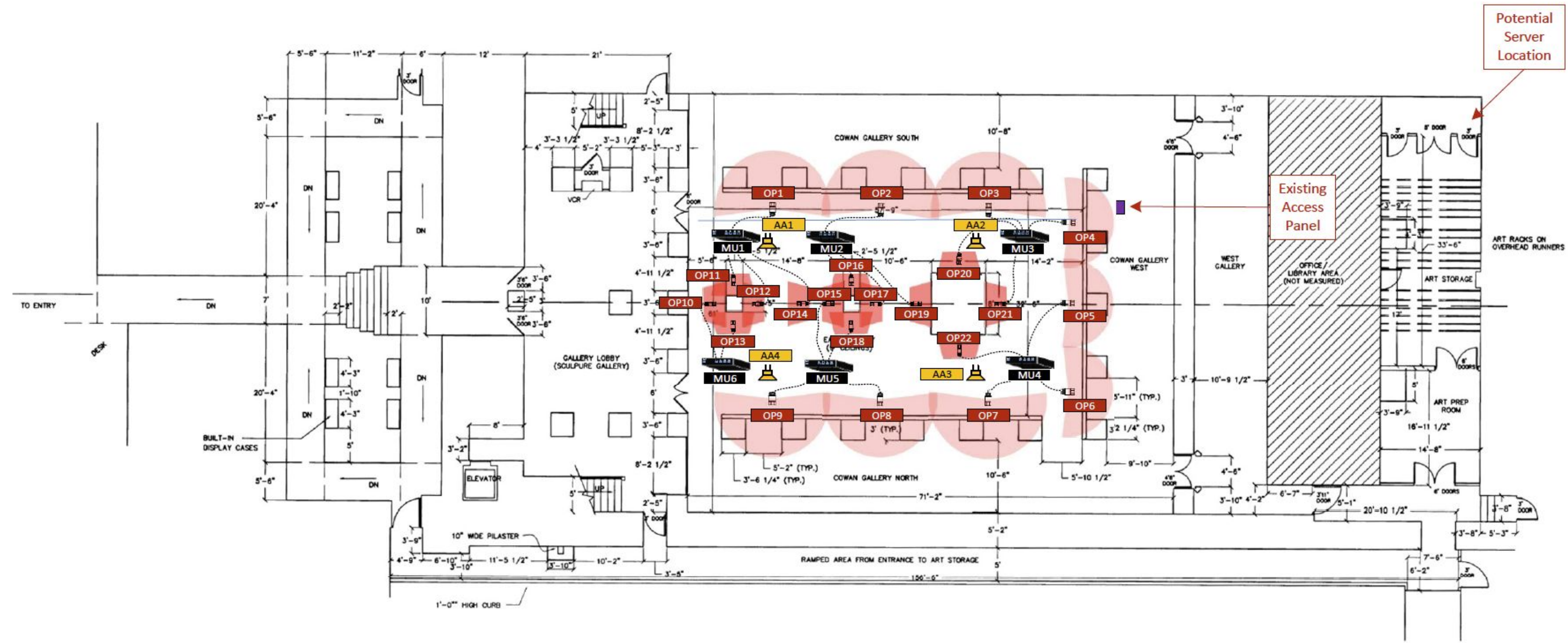
## Project Overview / Costs Brief:

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The Art Sentry system is an interlinked network of cameras, sensors, and audio devices that will connect directly its own server in the Parthenon museum. Pages 4-7 detail the planned installation locations on the Main Level and Nao Chamber/Treasury Room.

The installation for the system is projected to cost \$182,125. Centennial Park Conservancy will cover all project-related costs. No funding is required by Metro Parks for this project.

Over the last several months, representatives from CPC, Art Sentry, Metro ITS, Metro Parks Maintenance, and the Parthenon have been in contact to evaluate specific needs and responsibilities for this project. Each partner has signed off on this project, pending Park Board and Metro Council approval.

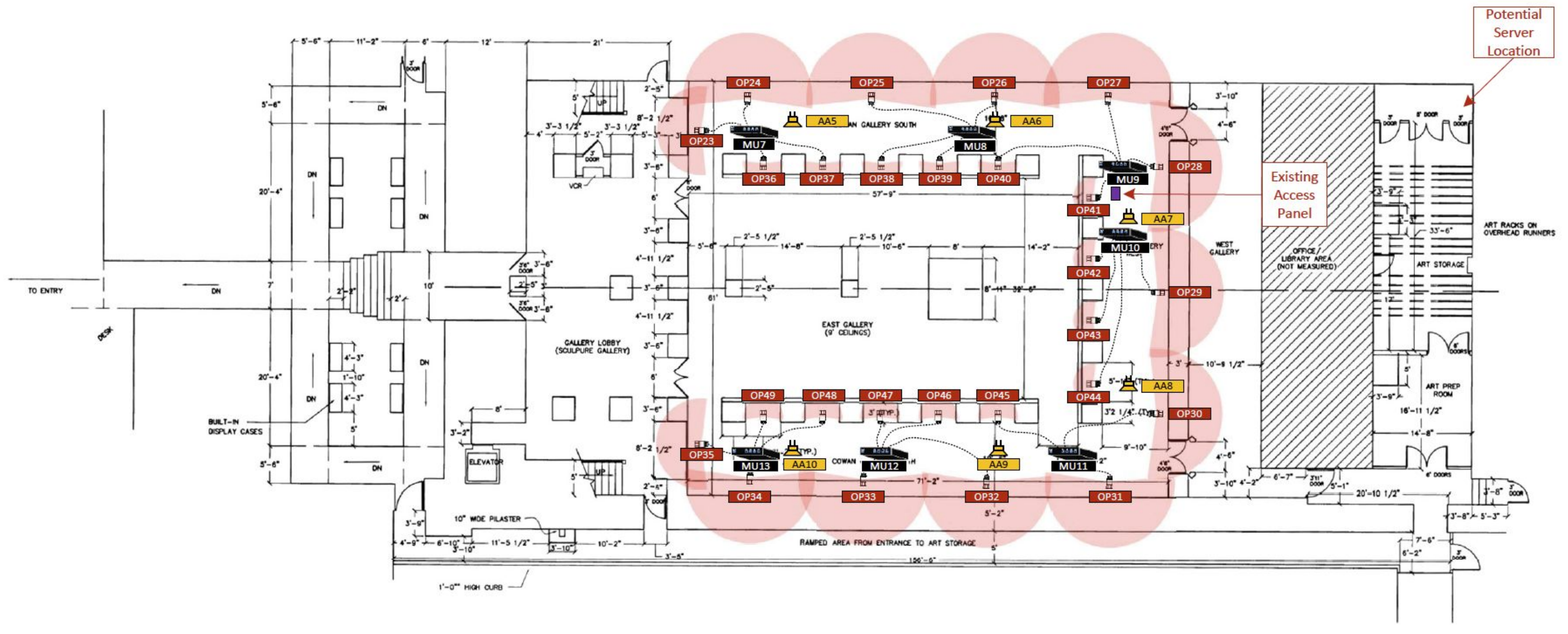


## Gallery Level Art Sentry Schematic

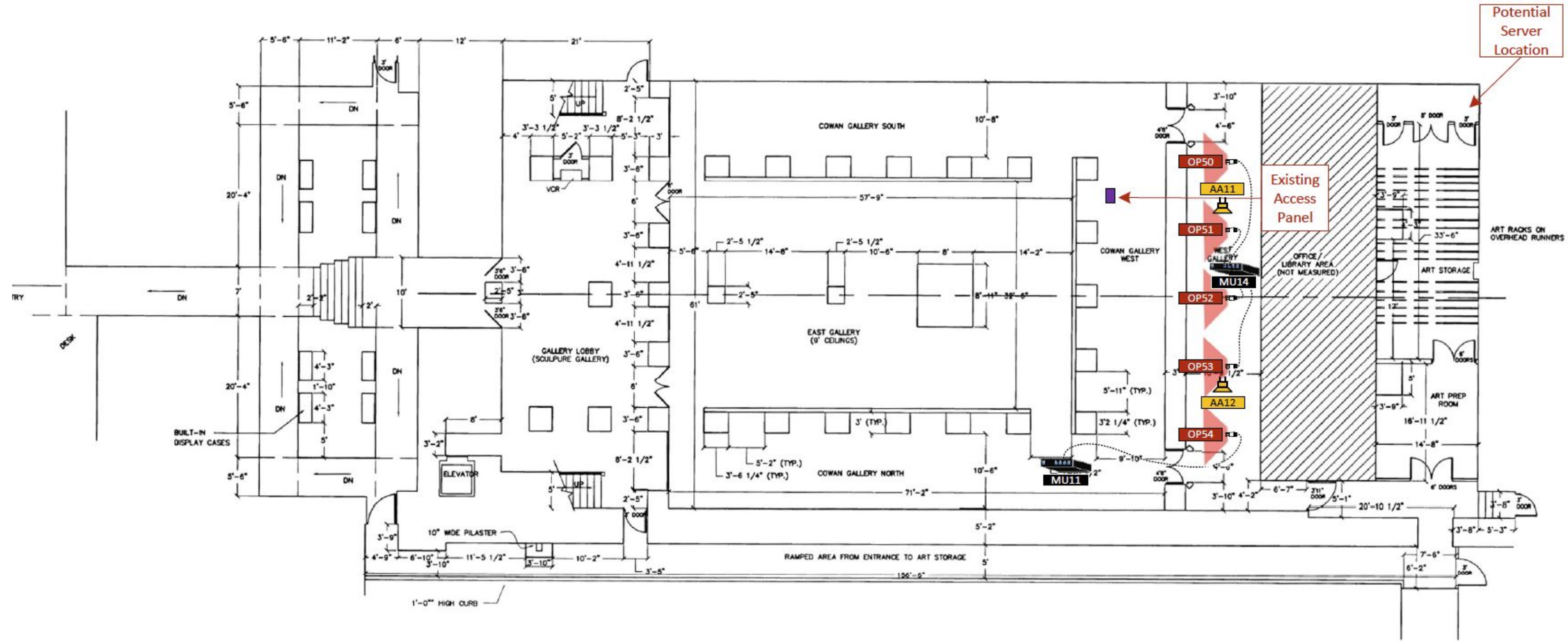

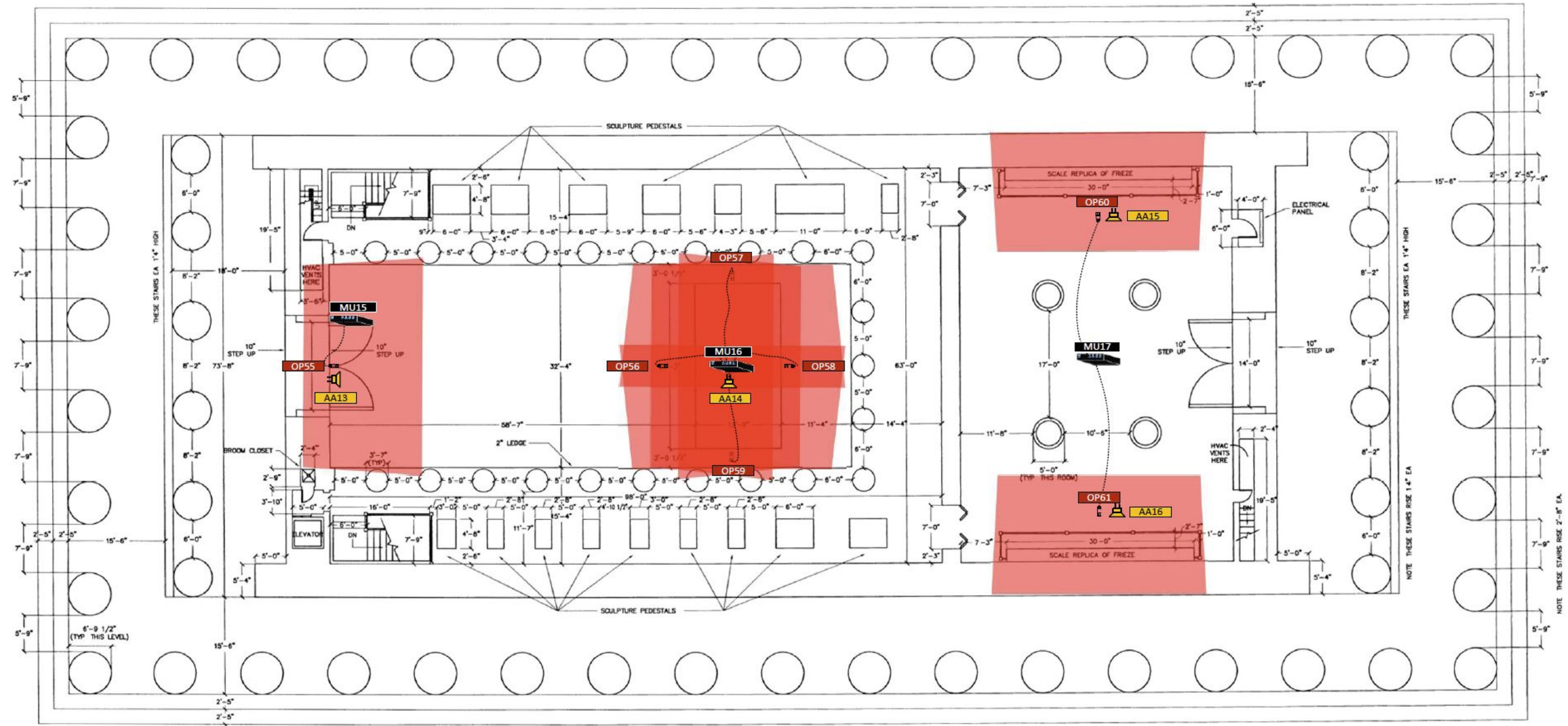

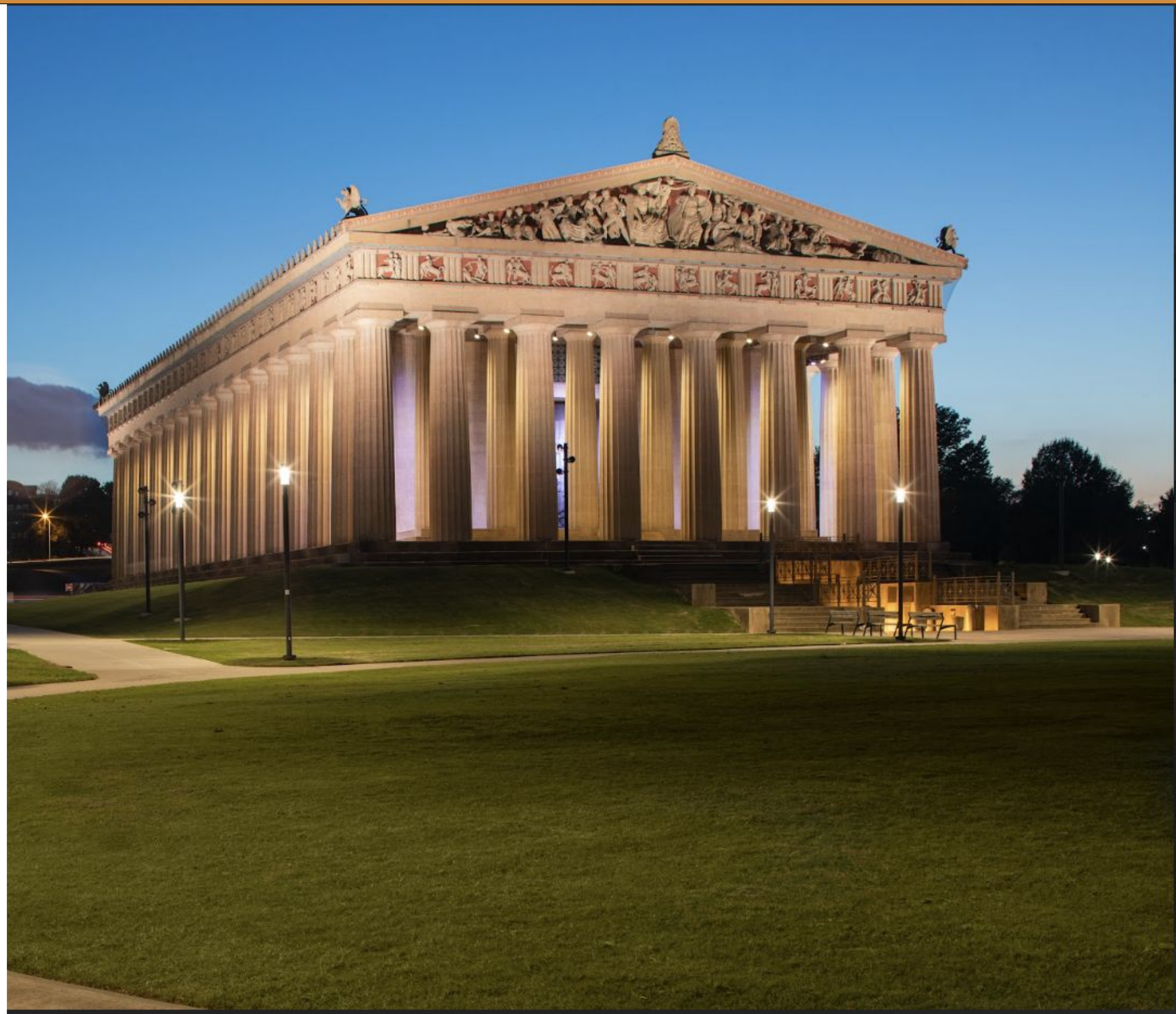
## Main Floor Art Sentry Schematic

## The Objective:

The Art Sentry security system, once installed, will be accessible by Parthenon staff in real-time via ipads or mobile devices. **Direct benefits of this system include:**

- 1) Constant oversight of all major museum assets, giving eyes and ears to necessary staff throughout operating hours.
- 2) Art Sentry sensors provide an invisible field of protection around all objects, with an automatic audio alert that directly, yet politely, informs visitors when they breach this field.
- 3) With this constant protection, staff are enabled to focus on serving visitors. Audio alerts also mitigate awkward staff/visitor interactions and allow staff and security to quickly intervene when necessary.
- 4) Overall, an Art Sentry system will result in stronger protections for the museum's assets, both temporary and permanent.




