BILL ON SECOND READING

6. <u>BL2024-183</u> (Evans Segall, Horton, Huffman & Others)

Referred to the Government Operations & Regulations Committee (Bradford)

Amends Title 16 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws to provide for housing, health, and safety of residents by streamlining Codes provisions related to fireproofing requirements for middle housing creation and conversion, including specifically the creation of a class of Large Unit Homes within the International Building Code and providing for NFPA-13D sprinklers and one-hour fire-resistance-rated separation therefore.
