An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to abandon public utility easement rights, for property located at 4101 William Turner Parkway, formerly a portion of Old Cane Ridge Road (Proposal No. 2022M-088ES-001).

WHEREAS, easement rights that were retained by Council Bill No. O73-790, for a 15 foot public utility easement along the west side of the property recorded on the plat of Mid South Auto Park, Book 6900, Page 659, R.O.D.C., TN, for property located at 4101 William Turner Parkway, formerly a portion of Old Cane Ridge Road, are no longer needed; and,

WHEREAS, the abandonment has been requested by Madison Century Farms Owner, LLC, owner; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2022M-088ES-001 on June 10, 2022, for the abandonment of said public utility easements rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon easement rights that were retained by Council Bill No. O73-790, for a 15 foot public utility easement along the west side of the property recorded on the plat of Mid South Auto Park, Book 6900, Page 659, R.O.D.C., TN, for property located at 4101 William Turner Parkway, formerly a portion of Old Cane Ridge Road, as shown below and on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference:




