Dear Parks Board Members,

Friends of Green Hills Park requests board approval of an in-kind grant to install a new water fountain by the playgrounds at Green Hills Park. The new water fountain will serve the many children and parents using the playground and will serve as a water source for our ongoing removal of invasive plants and replacement with native plants. The estimated total cost of the project, including the cost of tapping the road and purchasing the water fountain, is \$35,000. No money will be donated to Metro Parks. The project will be paid for directly by Friends of Green Hills Park with no financial match or other obligation to Metro Parks or Metro Government.

Friends of Green Hills Park also requests board approval of an in-kind grant to construct a Wind Telephone in Green Hills Park. This project has been proposed as an Eagle Scout project by Sean Meehan and the estimated total cost of the project is \$800.

The Wind Telephone Project is a contemplative initiative providing a space for people to connect emotionally with departed loved ones. Imagine a tranquil garden with a designated telephone booth, symbolizing a link to the ethereal realm.

Friends of Green Hills Park is a 501(c)(3) non-profit dedicated to improving our neighborhood park, building community & increasing walk and bike connectivity to nearby green spaces where we love to walk and play.

The benefits of the Wind Telephone Project are profound. It offers a therapeutic outlet for grief, providing a sense of connection with those who have passed away. The space becomes a site for rituals of remembrance, a communal space for shared experiences, and a platform for artistic expression. Symbolically, the act of sending messages on the wind brings comfort and peace, tapping into the enduring power of human connection and innovative approaches to healing in the face of loss. The project creates a tangible, symbolic, and supportive environment, acknowledging the complexity of grief while providing a source of solace and understanding.


The Wind Telephone is particularly appropriate for Green Hills Park, because there is already a display of ribbons with hand-written expressions of grief on the softball backstop in memory of the Covenant School victims. The display was initiated by West Nashville Sporting League and many of the expressions of grief are written to Evelyn Diekhaus, who played in the girls' softball league at the park.

Attached are two sketches and two photographs of the proposal. The project will be paid for directly by Sean or Friends of Green Hills Park with no financial match or other obligation to Metro Parks or Metro Government.

We are in communication with Metro Parks staff about these projects and will continue to work with them on the details of purchase and installation. Friends of Green Hills Park will not proceed with the projects until final written approval is provided by the appropriate Metro Parks staff.

We appreciate your consideration very much, as we work to improve and beautify our neighborhood park.

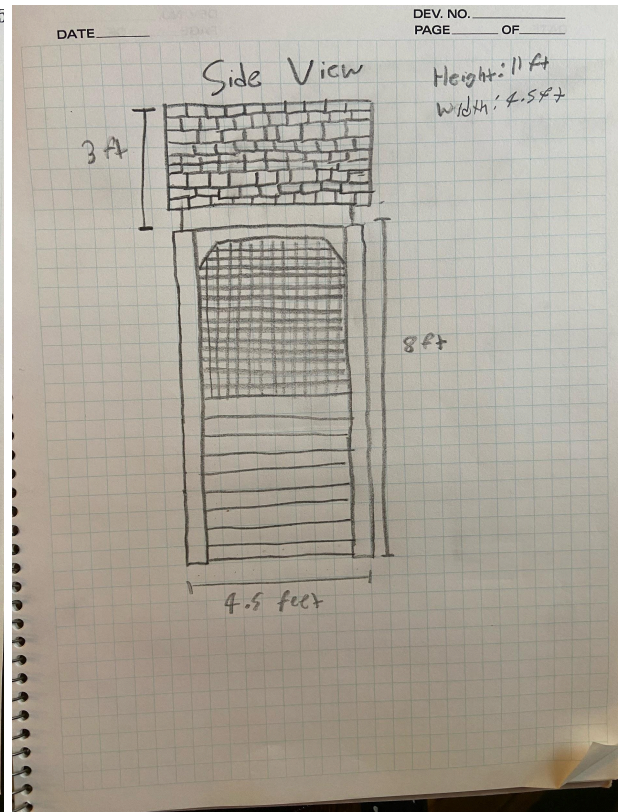
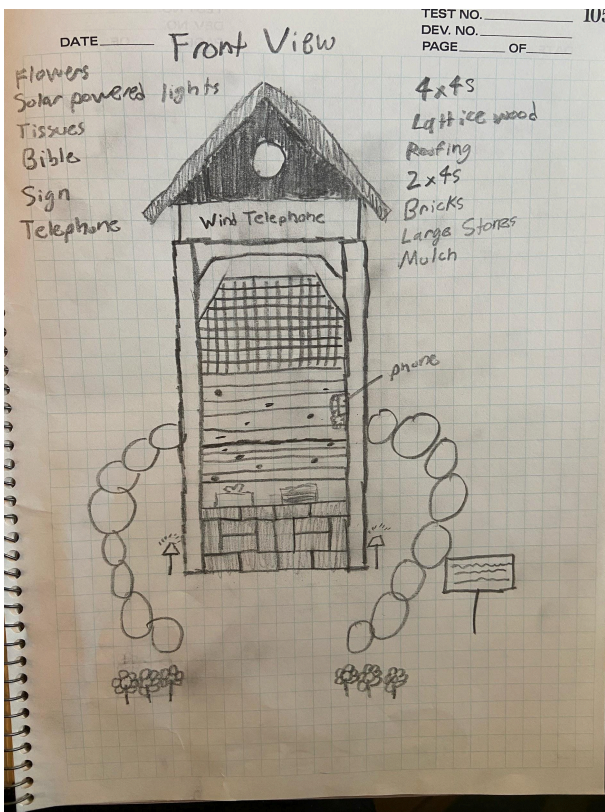


