On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the acceptance of approximately 1,635 linear feet of eight-inch water mains (DIP), approximately 630 linear feet of 12-inch water mains (DIP), three fire hydrant assemblies, approximately 1,247 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 12 sanitary sewer manholes, and associated easements to serve the Century Farms J Road development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
