

As you may know, the team at Sweetens Cove has a strong and growing affinity and respect for the role of Ted Rhodes in the Greater Nashville and Tennessee community. From its critical role in providing accessible golf to legions of fans and its important legacy in recognition of golf pioneers, we hold Ted Rhodes in high esteem. Like your golf course in Nashville, we are deeply-rooted in Tennessee and the culture and character of this game and its impact on generations of players, families and organizations.

At Sweetens, we have been blessed with economic and operational success at our Golf Club and the 2020 launch of our Spirits Company – becoming one of Tennessee's leading purveyors of ultra-premium bourbons. We're proud of our home base and are committed to building our company here.

To celebrate the launch of our newest bourbon product – called Sweetens Cove Kennessee – we have begun a project called *Give-A-Little*, where we are dedicating a portion of our sales to local and small-town golf courses throughout the nation who embody many of the same attributes and spirit as our golf course in South Pittsburg. We'll take \$5 from every one of the first 10,000 bottles sold, generating a total of \$50,000 to share with these courses, who could use a "little" support and assistance with the little things – from a new ice machine to driving range mats or benches on the course. Because if anyone knows the importance of these little courses, Sweetens Cove certainly does.

We would like to recognize Ted Rhodes Golf Course as our first recipient of our Give-A-Little project – consistent with the vision described above. In the case of Ted Rhodes, we envision an investment of up to \$8,000 for some potential projects, which would include landscaping, a new flag-pole, lighting, signage or other particular need. *This is an "in-kind" grant with no match or other obligation to Metro or Parks for this contribution on our part.*

Peyton Manning, my partner in Sweetens Cove, also has a growing media content business, Omaha Productions, and they would love to build a small video of this story of Ted Rhodes and our Give-A-Little. This would be an impactful tool to share the wonderful history of your golf destination.

We're hopeful hat we can collaborate on this and excited for another Spring of golf, community and fellowship at Ted Rhodes. Thank you to you and all of the stakeholders – including metro government and its leadership – for your consideration.
