On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 244 linear feet of eight-inch sewer main, one sanitary sewer manhole and easements, and the acceptance of approximately 430 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), approximately 526 linear feet of new eight-inch sewer main (DIP), four new sanitary sewer manholes and any associated easements, to serve the Riverside Residential development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
