**Re: Shelby House Phase 2

On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval with conditions* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 297 linear feet of existing 10-inch sanitary sewer main, and the acceptance of one sanitary sewer manhole, to serve the Shelby House Phase 2 Development. New sanitary sewer manhole will be in the right-of-way. This portion of the project will not abandon the easement as it is currently located in the right-of-way.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, General Services-Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.

Conditions that apply to this approval:

All work must maintain clearances with any utility poles to prevent undermining the integrity of the foundation.
