On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 401 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), one sanitary sewer manhole and easements, and the acceptance of approximately 410 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three sanitary sewer manholes, and easements to serve 245 Ensworth Place development.
