On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 29 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (VCP), and the acceptance of approximately 348 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 29 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three sanitary sewer manholes and any associated easements to serve the Fairview Meadows development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, General Services-Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
