

Dear Monique,

I'm writing to request that the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation accept a grant of \$35,836.00 for the installation and first two years' monthly expenses for Wi-Fi at the Parthenon

Earlier this year, the Parthenon staff requested we explore the possibility of underwriting the installation of WiFi in the building to enable the presentation virtual museum programming and enhance the visitor experience by having access to WiFi. This would also enable the delivery of future programming such as a Parthenon smart phone app with interactive elements and guided tours. The \$23,836 installation quote was provided to us by Chuddy Nnodu, Wireless Network in Engineer in the Metro ITS Department.

Centennial Park Conservancy will be responsible for all installation expenses, even if they exceed this amount. The installation expenses and \$12,000 in internet service fees for the first two years is being jointly underwritten by Centennial Park Conservancy and the Frist Foundation. Centennial Park Conservancy would be responsible for future internet service fees beyond that time and any equipment maintenance. There is no match or any other obligation to Parks or Metro related to this grant




