25 - SUV Response vehicle	\$1,250,000	Response vehicles to provide fire and medical intervention with rapid response personnel (Fastcars; Assistant/District Chief Response)
30 - SUV / Pick-Up Truck Response Vehicles	\$1,250,500	Response vehicles to provide fire and medical intervention with rapid response personnel (Fire Prevention)
3 - Logistics Response Vehicles	\$90,000	Logistic Vehicles to provide essential delivery of fire and medical supplies and equipment
3 - Facilities maintenance equipment vehicles	\$105,000	Facilities vehicles to provide essential delivery and maintenance of medical supplies, safety supplies and equipment

50 - Cardiac Monitors	\$1,900,000	Response equipment to provide enhanced medical care to monitor oxygen saturation and EKG vitals
2 - Shower / Toilet Trailers	150,000	2 Shower/Toilet Trailers will be initially placed at the Training Academy to provide additional cleaning stations and allow for proper distancing between recruits. Each trailer would provide 6 individual toilets and 6 individual showers. With 2 Fire Recruit classes operating concurrently along with in-service and EMS class, it is critical that NFD have sufficient facilities to safely train while mitigating COVID risk.
